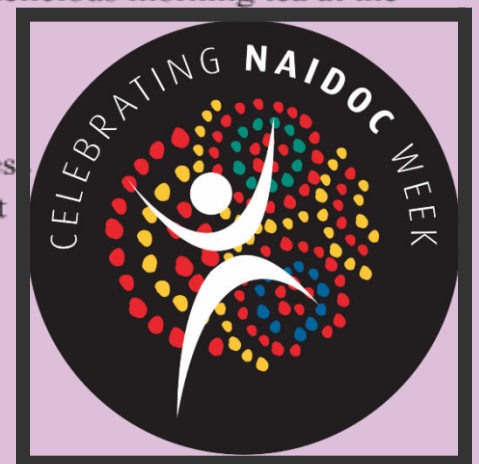


Celebrating NAIDOC Week 2022

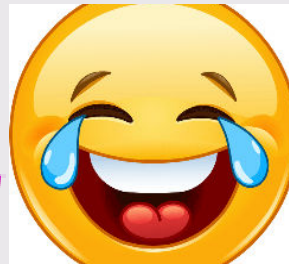
My Aged
